25 Yard Short Course
6 & Under Timed Finals, Relay Timed Finals
8 & Under, 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18 preliminaries, finals and consolation finals.
Championship finals will be swum prior to consolation finals.
- Date and Time:** Saturday and Sunday June 13 & 14, 2009
Prelim Session will begin at 9:00 AM, Saturday and Sunday
6&U Session will be Sunday, not before 11:30 AM with 30 minutes warmup
Finals will begin at 5:00 PM on Saturday and 4:30 PM on Sunday
Warm-up for morning prelims begins at 7:30 am both days.
Warm-up for finals begins 4:00pm Saturday and 3:30pm Sunday.
- Location:** The Doyle Aquatic Center at the Long Center

- Pool Specs:** Certified 25 yard indoor heated pool, non-turbulent lanes,
10 lanes for prelims, 8 lanes for finals
A buffer lane is provided with multiple lanes for continuous warm-up, warm-down.
Pool depth is 7-1/2 feet to 12 feet at start end.
All 25 yard events will start at the south end of the pool.
KDI Paragon Starting blocks will be used for all events.
- Timing Equipment:** Daktronics Timing System with Scoreboard
- Warm-up:** General warm up: 7:30 AM for Session I prelims
General warm up: 30 minutes guaranteed for 6&U Session
One hour warm up prior to each Final Session - 4pm for Saturday and 3:30 for Sunday.
Teams will be assigned warm-up lanes based upon number of swimmers.
Continuous warm up and warm down during meet in multiple lanes.
- Eligibility:** Open to all registered USA Swimming athletes who are members of invited summer teams
in good standing with Private Club League
- Seeding:** 25 yard short course times will be used for seeding.

Scratches:

PRELIMS: No penalty for scratches on the blocks.

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FINALS: Any swimmer who competes in a preliminary heat and qualifies in the top 16 as originally seeded, must swim in that event's final or consolation final; or must submit their intention to scratch from that event within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers. Swimmers may reverse their intention to scratch and choose to be seeded for finals if they do so within 30 minutes of their last event of the day. Any swimmer seeded in a final who fails to swim that event will be barred from further competition in the meet, unless excused by the Meet Referee because of illness or emergency. The Meet Referee must be notified prior to the event taking place.

Coaches are encouraged to scratch swimmers seeded in the top 24 if not returning for finals

If there is an open lane in Championship finals, the fastest qualifier in consolation finals will be offered that lane. Designated alternates wishing to swim in open lanes in consolation finals must check in with the deck referee and stand at the starters table ready to swim when the swimmers are called to the blocks. Only the starter may call for alternates.

Entry Limit:

Limited to (3) three individual events and (2) two relays per swimmer

Each team may enter only one relay team per event.

Over entries will automatically be dropped when they exceed the limit in the meet.

Entry Form:

Entries must be submitted on HyTek export format accompanied by a hard copy and payment. Teams choosing to submit entries in hard copy form only will be charged an additional \$50.00. Entries will be accepted via e-mail to eva@swimresultsbytrg.com

E-Mail entries must be accompanied by a backup hard copy of the entry, list of all attending coaches, contact phone numbers, and a summary of financial information as outlined on the Master Entry Form. Current USA swimming registration number, full name, age, and entry time must be listed. All entry and Master Entry Forms must be signed.

Finals: Each Championship Final will be swum first so that vacancies can be filled from the Consolation Final. Consolation Final qualifers are asked to be at designated block to be considered for any vacancies in Championship Final. Alternate Final qualifiers are asked to be standing behind Starter at the time of the related Consolation Final.

Rules: 2009 USA Swimming Rules and PCL By-Laws will govern the Meet. Declared false starts and deliberate delays of the meet will be treated the same as "failure to swim".
NO PARENT'S OR SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON DECK UNLESS THEY ARE WORKING TIMERS OR CHAPERONES WITH PASSES.

Team Rep: Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person, other than the Coach, who will check with the referee about any matters pertaining to the meet may be given to the referee. For each team, the Coach and that person ONLY will be recognized.

Meet Requirements: Each team is responsible for providing timers and chaperones.

Chaperones: Each team will be allowed chaperones on the pool deck for their swimmers. Teams with 50 or less swimmers will be allowed 4 chaperones and 50 or more swimmers will be allowed 8 chaperones. For the 6&U session, small teams will have 2, large teams will have 4 chaperones. CCCA will provide lanyards with id badges for each chaperone. Each team will be provided with complimentary heat sheets for coaches and chaperones. Teams must submit a list of chaperones by June 4th via email to: ianoneil71@yahoo.com.

Timers: Each team must provide 3 timers for Prelims and Finals both Saturday and Sunday and for the 6&U session. Team must submit a list of timers by June 4th via email to: ianoneil71@yahoo.com

Identification: All coaches and officials must be prepared to provide current proof of membership in USA Swimming and shall wear their USA Swimming Card in a conspicuous location at all times while on the pool deck during the swim meet.

Procedures:**

Absolutely no equipment at any time. Swimmers must enter the water feet first with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck, except when executing a controlled racing start, supervised by a coach.
